The Black Ant is the most commonly encountered Ravager. Unless numbers are absolutely overwhelming-engage. They are susceptible to all standard issue weapons; explosive weapons are particularly effective.



Cautiously engage; maintain as much distance as possible. Small arms fire is very effective against Wolf Spiders, but the danger they pose has less to do with their defensive capabilities than their offensive. When multiple Wolf Spiders are encountered at close range, troops are advised to exercise as much mobility as possible while maintaining combat effectiveness. Remaining on the move is especially vital after being webbed—Wolf Spiders are guick to capitalize on the advantage a mobility-impaired target presents.

Stay alert and stay on the move. The Wasp is susceptible to small arms fire, but it can withstand some punishment. Heat seeking projectiles are optimum against them—the higher yield the better.




Maintain safe distance, if possible, and engage. Ticks are very susceptible to even standard issue light weapons fire. If kept at a distance, Ticks pose little threat. However, if allowed to close, Ticks are extremely dangerous. In close quarters situations, Troops are advised to keep moving—a stationary soldier is easy prey for Ticks. If latched onto by a Tick, very fast action of the part of a Trooper or one of his squad mates is required to avoid explosive results.









Main Force EDF Units below full platoon strength should avoid engagement. Engaging units should deploy assault rifle detachments to counter the Ticks, freeing Troopers with explosive weapons to go after the Bomber itself. Strike Force Units have clearance to engage, using discretion.

Thus far, the DLL has no known vulnerabilities. Main Force EDF should not engage. Strike Force Units are cleared for probing engagements to find weaknesses or vulnerabilities. Any and all data acquired on the DLL should be IMMEDIATELY reported to Operations and Intelligence.

Main Force EDF Troopers should immediately report Mantis sightings to Operations or Intel, then exfiltrate ASAP, if at all possible. Refrain from engaging unless absolutely necessary and clearance is granted. Strike Force Units are advised to observe and engage, with extreme caution.
